HIGH-SPEED RAIL: More Than A Transportation Program

- California is 8th Largest Economy in the World
- Comparable to Northeast Corridor in Terms of Distance, Population and Complexity
- Transformative Investment
- Connecting all California Population Centers



WHY HIGH-SPEED RAIL IN CALIFORNIA?

- **Curbs Congestion**

- » LAX to SFO is the **Busiest Short-Haul Market** in US
- » 1 in 6 Flights out of LA Heads to Bay Area
- » Six of Top 30 Congested Urban Areas in US Located in California

- **Population Growth**

- » Estimated to Reach **50 Million by 2050**

- **Air Quality/Sustainability**

- » Meets Goals of AB 32/SB 375
- » **Worst Air** Communities in the Country

- **Alternatives are Costly**

- » 2-3 Times **More Expensive**



KEY MILESTONES

- **Funding:**

- » \$3.3 Billion Federal and \$4.7 Billion Prop 1A
- » 25% of Future Cap and Trade Proceeds

- **Environmental Clearances:**

- » Merced to Fresno: May 2012
- » Fresno to Bakersfield: June 2014

- **Construction Packages:**

- » CP 1 Executed in August, Under \$1 Billion
- » CP 2-3 Currently Out to Bid, Execution Expected by End of 2014

- » Advance multiple segments of high-speed rail
- » Complete planned regional transportation improvements
- » Establish an interstate high-speed rail system with a connection to Las Vegas from Palmdale

 - » Peninsula Corridor Joint Powers Board – Environmental Review Underway
- Transbay Terminal
 - » Construction Proceeding

CENTRAL VALLEY: BACKBONE OF HIGH-SPEED RAIL

- Construction Package 1
 - » 29 Miles Between Madera and Fresno
 - » Work is Underway
- Construction Package 2-3
 - » 65 Miles Between Fresno and Tulare-Kern County Line
 - » Environmental Clearances Complete
 - » Procuring Design-Build Contractor



TIMELINE (SUBJECT TO CHANGE)

- **October 20:** RFQs Issued
- **October 31:** Last Day to Submit Written Questions
- **December 5:** SOQs Due by 4:00 p.m. (PST)
- **December 29:** Notice of Selection
- **February 3, 2015:** Authority Board Consideration of Contracts
- **February 17, 2015:** Anticipated Award of Contracts

EVALUATION PROCESS

- The Authority Evaluation/Selection Committee Shall Review and Evaluate Each Statement of Qualification to **Determine if it Meets the Requirements Contained in Section 4.0 and Attachment B** of the RFQ.
- Following the Evaluation of SOQs, the Authority Will Hold **Discussions/Interviews with Selected Offerors**.
- The Evaluation/Selection Committee Will Then Recommend the **Top Ranking Offeror for Award of the Contract** and **Enter into Negotiations**.

PROCUREMENT INFORMATION

- May Submit SOQs on Multiple Regional Consultant Procurements
 - » Must Submit Separate Statements of Qualifications
 - » SOQs will be Reviewed Independently
- If Shortlisted for Multiple Procurements
 - » May Elect Which Procurement to Pursue and Withdraw from the Other
 - » May Pursue Multiple Procurements in Which Case at the Interviews, Offeror Must Present a Detailed Description of its Willingness and Capacity to Allocate Sufficient Resources for Multiple Contracts

- The RFQ Solicitation Shall Follow the Process in **California Code of Regulations**
- Offerors are Required to Comply with the Participation by **Small, Disadvantaged and Disabled Veteran Business Enterprises**

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
