The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) is seeking Statements of Qualifications for a statewide vision plan for high-speed rail stations. While every station area is unique and should reflect local context, culture and climate, the vision plan should be designed to embrace the value that high-speed rail places on sustainability, architecture and urbanism.

The Authority intends to enter into a contract with a qualified firm to provide professional consulting services to create a set of common design elements and key features to be incorporated in all stations that will identify them as part of the California High-Speed Rail system. These may include standard, dimensioned drawings and specifications for system and facility identity elements. The resulting contract will include the Board-adopted 30 percent small business participation goal.
