HIGH-SPEED RAIL STATION PLANNING

- Readiness for Ridership
 - » Accessible: Easily accessible by all modes of transportation
 - » Integrated: Integrates with the surrounding community creating a welcoming and inviting place
 - » Connected: Connects to the broader city and region
 - » Functional: Provides a safe place for passengers to move freely to, through and from the station



HIGH-SPEED RAIL STATION PLANNING

- Readiness for Development
 - » Prepared: Local plans and policies that are supportive and promote HSR-oriented development
 - » Proactive: Attract investment to the station area




STATION PLANNING CONSIDERATIONS

- Design sustainable buildings





STATION BASICS

- Connects to:


- » Local and regional buses
- » Metro rail: Red/Purple and Gold Lines
- » Metrolink lines: Antelope Valley, Inland Empire-OC, Orange County, Riverside, San Bernardino, Ventura County, 91
- » Amtrak rail and buses
- » Private bus: Greyhound, Megabus, Bolt Bus, LAX Flyaway, etc.
- » Regional Connector (under construction)



ARTIC STATION

• Connects to:

- » Local and regional buses
 - OCTA bus connections
 - Anaheim Resort Transportation (ART)
- » Metrolink Orange County Line
- » Amtrak Pacific Surfliner & Thruway Bus
- » Private bus: Greyhound, Megabus
- » Proposed Anaheim Rapid Connection (ARC)



STATION OPTION: NORWALK / SANTA FE SPRINGS

- Connects to:

- » Local buses
- » Metrolink lines: Orange County & 91
- » Norwalk Transit System (NTS) bus connection
- » Metro Green Line (Bus transfer to Green Line Station)



STATION OPTION: FULLERTON

- Connects to:

- » Local and regional buses
- » Metrolink lines: Orange County & 91
- » Amtrak Pacific Surfliner, Thruway Bus Route 39 & Southwest Chief
