



Bakersfield F Street Station Alignment (BFSSA)

Join us to learn about recent alignment refinements and additional conceptual station information

The California High-Speed Rail Authority (Authority) and the Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) invite you to attend a community open house to learn about recent refinements to the Bakersfield F Street Station Alignment (BFSSA). The BFSSA is located between the cities of Shafter and Bakersfield in the Central Valley and is being studied as part of the draft Fresno to Bakersfield supplemental environmental document, which will include the identification of resources protected by Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966 and Section 4(f) of the Department of Transportation Act of 1966.

The Authority has been working with the cities of Bakersfield and Shafter, as well as local residents, stakeholders and regulatory agencies to refine an alignment that includes a station at the intersection of F Street and Golden State Avenue. This is an opportunity for the community to ask questions and provide comments about the alignment that is being studied.
